

Morning supervision begins at 8:55 daily. Doors are locked until that time so we can make sure students are safely monitored by an adult. The students go directly to their classrooms for breakfast; official start time is 9:10 AM. Thank you for having your child to school on time if you are transporting.

Please call the office by 9:30 if your child will be arriving late, and remember to call in if your child will be absent or if you will be picking up early.

Dismissal is at 4:07 PM. If you are picking your child up early, please remember to stop by the office to sign out for the day.

Please stay in your cars and wait for staff to direct you to the drop off/pick up spots and they will help your child exit the vehicle. Make sure your child exits the vehicle on the passengers side of the car which is closest to the sidewalk. We have many students being picked up this year and are asking for your patience as we load kids into vehicles safely.

As always, thank you for making school attendance a priority, but also keeping your child home if he/ she is ill. We appreciate your support with keeping Eureka a safe, happy and healthy place to learn and work.
