



I Move for Hal Scholarship Information

The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships to deserving St. Johns High School students who show exemplary commitment to their community and the world around them.

Eligibility:

Eligible applicants must be a senior at St. Johns High School and meet the following minimum criteria for consideration:

- Candidates must have completed a minimum of 40 hours of volunteer work over their four years in high school.
- Individual must possess a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Must have a minimum of one letter of reference regarding the volunteer work performed.

Eligible applicants must respond to the following essay questions. The Scholarship Board will evaluate the essays based on creativity, thoughtfulness and development. Each essay will be limited to 200 words or less, or combined 500 words or less.

Questions: How will you continue your volunteerism after graduation? In what ways will you make an impact on your community as a volunteer?

Amount: 2 Scholarships will be awarded of \$1,500.00

Background on the Scholarship:

The "I Move for Hal Scholarship" was created in 2015 by Katie Eccleton in honor of her late father Hal Rice who lost his battle in 2013 with Multiple Sclerosis. The scholarship was created after much fundraising and a promise Katie made to her Dad to spread the word about this disease. Hal was a constant supporter of his family and community.
