Drop-Off Procedure

- 1. Use the back parking lot.
- Pull as far forward as you can.
 Do not stop in front of the door if there is room in front of you.
- 3. Stay in your vehicle.
- 4. Let your student out of the car on the passenger side only.
- 5. Once your student is out of the car, pull away so others can access the drop off lane.

Pick-Up Procedure

- 1. Use the back parking lot.
- Use your Pick Up hanging sign and pull as far forward as possible
- 3. Stay in your vehicle.
- Let your student in the car on the passenger side only.
- 5. Once your student is in the car, pull away so others can access the pick up lane.
