# INTRODUCTION

The following report focuses on facts and figures highlighting the 2012-13 school year at St. Johns High School pertaining to interscholastic athletics. The report addresses several components of the Athletic Program including league affiliation, sport offerings, classifications and coaching statistics. However, the intent of these findings relate directly to the opportunities provided to student-athletes through their participation in interscholastic athletics, and the benefits experienced that will serve as lessons for a life-time.

The 2012-13 school year was an astounding success for the student-athletes, coaches and teams in the eighth year of competing in the Capital Area Activities Conference (CAAC).

**Redwing success** included one CAAC Championship, two MHSAA Team District Championships, one MHSAA Team Regional Championship, seven teams earned Academic All-State Honors, 11 student-athletes earned Academic All-State Honors, 9 All-State Athletes, and eight Individual State Champions. The Varsity Wrestling Team capped off a success school year by winning its fourth consecutive MHSAA Team State Championship.
