# INTRODUCTION

The following report focuses on facts and figures highlighting the 2014-15 school year at St. Johns High School pertaining to interscholastic athletics. The report addresses several components of the Athletic Program including league affiliation, sport offerings, classifications and coaching statistics. However, the intent of these findings relate directly to the opportunities provided to student-athletes through their participation in interscholastic athletics, and the benefits experienced that will serve as lessons for a life-time.

The 2014-15 school year was an astounding success for the student-athletes, coaches and teams while competing in the Capital Area Activities Conference (CAAC). **Redwing success** included six (6) CAAC Championships, two (2) MHSAA Team District Championships, seven (7) teams earned Academic All-State Honors, 22 student-athletes earned Academic All-State Honors, 27 All-State Athletes, and five (5) coaches earned post season honors. To highlight the year's success, five (5) student-athletes won Individual State Championships and the Varsity Girls Track and Field Team won the MHSAA Division II Team State Championship, the sixth team state championship in school history.
