# INTRODUCTION

The following report focuses on facts and figures highlighting the 2016-17 school year at St. Johns High School pertaining to interscholastic athletics. The report addresses several components of the Athletic Program including league affiliation, sport offerings, classifications and coaching statistics. However, the intent of these findings relate directly to the opportunities provided to student-athletes through their participation in interscholastic athletics, and the benefits experienced that will serve as lessons for a life-time.

The 2016-17 school year was an astounding success for the student-athletes, coaches and teams while competing in the Capital Area Activities Conference (CAAC). **Redwing success** included seven (7) CAAC Team Championships, one (1) MHSAA Team District Championship, one (1) MHSAA Team Regional Championship, wrestling advanced to the MHSAA Division Two State Quarterfinals, and boys golf won the MHSAA Division II Team State Championship. Furthermore, seven (7) teams earned Team Academic All-State Honors, (26) student-athletes earned Individual Academic All-State Honors, (30) student-athletes earned All-State Honors, and two (2) student-athletes won individual state championships.
