 - Scholar Recipients will matriculate into a 4-year college/university this summer or fall
 - Scholar Recipients must submit a copy of their college enrollment verification information via email or U.S. mail by **September 30, 2023**. No extensions will be given.
 - The Scholar Recipients will be awarded a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship
