# INTRODUCTION

The following report focuses on the facts and figures highlighting the 2019-20 school year at St. Johns High School pertaining to interscholastic athletics. The report addresses several components of the Athletic Program including league affiliation, sport offerings, classifications and coaching statistics. However, the intent of these findings relate directly to the opportunities provided to student-athletes through their participation in interscholastic athletics, and the benefits experienced that will serve as lessons for a life-time.

The 2019-20 school year was like no other as a result of the COVID-19 crisis that ended the winter season prematurely, the spring season on March 12, 2020, and the remainder of the school year. Although spring teams officially practiced just four days, student-athletes were granted season completion honors in regards to final participation numbers as long as they were on an official team roster as of March 12, 2020.

Prior to the start of the spring season, Redwing teams won three Capital Area Activities Conference (CAAC) Championships, Volleyball won the MHSAA District Championship, six teams earned Academic All-State Honors, several teams finished high in state tournament participation and nine student-athletes earned All-State Honors.
