



## ST. JOHNS ENRICHMENT POLICIES

Students enrolled in St. Johns High School day classes may increase the number of credits earned by enrolling in the enrichment program. If students choose to enroll in this program, they may do so under the following conditions:

1. Enrollment in enrichment courses is possible if:
  - a. the student is requesting to take electives to make up credit deficiencies,
  - b. the student is requesting to take a required course failed in day school.
2. The student must receive permission from the high school principal, counseling office, and from parents (if under 18) to participate in the program.
3. The student will agree to follow all rules and guidelines of the program and be aware that violations may result in the students being eliminated from further participation in the program.

### Enrichment Program Rules

1. All course work is done through the Edgenuity computer program.
2. The student is responsible for providing his/her own computer and internet connectivity.
3. Student will enroll in After-School Credit Recovery Google Classroom  
Code = **s4afhj7**
4. Student will read information in google classroom and will watch videos (links within google docs)
5. Student **MUST** have class completed within 15 weeks of start date. Courses not completed within this time frame **WILL** result in forfeiture of course fee, no credit earned for the enrolled course, and the course will be deleted from Edgenuity site (if student takes this course as online course again, he/she will have to start from beginning of course, not where he/she last left off).
6. **ALL TESTS AND EXAM** must be completed in person. Students must make an appointment with the teacher (Mr. Cramer: [cramerc@sjredwings.org](mailto:cramerc@sjredwings.org)) to take each test and exam. All other coursework may be completed at home.

### Student Progress Communication

1. Each week, an email will be sent to the student (student email) and parent (email listed on enrollment form). The email will list the overall percent of the class that the student has completed. Students should complete about 7% per week.
