Application Deadline is April 1, 2023 with no

- Reside in Clinton County or graduating from a Clinton County School in 2023
- Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and

DETAILED ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS DETAILS

To be eligible Applicants must:

- Reside in Clinton County or be a graduate of a Clinton County High School in 2023
- Have maintained a cumulative GPA of 2.5 and
- Be enrolled or plan to enroll in an accredited program offering a Certificate of Completion, Associate's Degree, or Bachelor's Degree in a Skilled Trades or Health Care Program.

Educational Institution Requirements

The applicant must use the scholarship awarded to attend a post-secondary institution of learning that requires a high school diploma for admission. This could include any public or private four-year accredited college or university; two-year accredited college; or vocational/technical college or training institution.

Application Criteria and Supporting Materials Required

- 1. Completed and signed application form
- 2. An official copy of the applicant's transcript and grade report from their High School
- 3. At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher in support of the applicant's application. Additional letters from the school administrator, counselor, or employment supervisor may also be provided in support of the application although they are not required. Do not send letters of recommendation from immediate family members, close family friends, or relatives, they will not be considered and application could be denied
- 4. A typewritten statement between 150-200 words prepared and signed by the applicant which explains his/her reasons for wanting to pursue a career in the chosen field of study.

Payment of Scholarship Proceeds

The student (s) selected to receive a scholarship will be awarded a Certificate of Eligibility at the Student Awards Program with financial payment made payable to the school once proof of enrollment from the school of choice has been received by the DeWitt Area Chamber of Commerce.
