Please construct a narrative response to the following prompt:

- What did he or she do to make a difference in your life?
- How did his or her involvement in your life directly contribute to the building of your character OR cause you to become more service-minded?

Be specific in your explanation; show how this person and his or her influence had a direct impact on your behavior, actions, and/or worldview.

Your essay should be:

- > at least one, and no more than two, pages in length
- > typed in 12-point Times New Roman font
- double spaced, with one-inch margins (top, bottom, right, left)
- edited for diction (word choice), syntax (sentence structure), paragraphing, grammar and spelling
