Future Educator Scholarship: (minimum GPA: 3.0)

A one-time \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who plans on a future career in education. The members of SJEA believe that teaching is one of the most important professions in our society and want to do their part to assist students who envision themselves becoming a future educator. Applicants must fill out an application and write a short essay explaining their philosophy of education and reasons for choosing teaching as a profession.

Community Service Scholarship: (minimum GPA: 3.0)

A one-time \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior who has made a real difference volunteering in their community. A requirement of this scholarship is a commitment of at least 100 volunteer hours while in high school. Applicants must fill out an application and write a short essay explaining how they have impacted others in positive ways through their community service activities.

Applications for these scholarships are available in the Guidance Office with a deadline of 3PM April 14, 2023.
