Playground structures/Fundraising ideas – Mr. Corr showed the group the various structures he picked out from Landscape Structures Company (they also did the East Lansing School playgrounds). The new playground committee will meet with Tim from Landscape Structure Co. to discuss plans, look at the site etc and this info will be brought to the next meeting The following prices are for the structure only:

Crab Trap - \$65150 (much larger)

Zip Krooz - \$13195 (x2 if we get a double)

We also need to cover cost of the initial wood chip load and excavation of the site

Family Movie Night – will be held March 13th, showing Frozen II, will have costume contest – winner takes home the movie, will pre-sell tix to have an idea on how much popcorn/drinks to have. All funds will go towards the playground structure from ticket sales, and concession sales will be used to pay for the movie license and popcorn cost.
